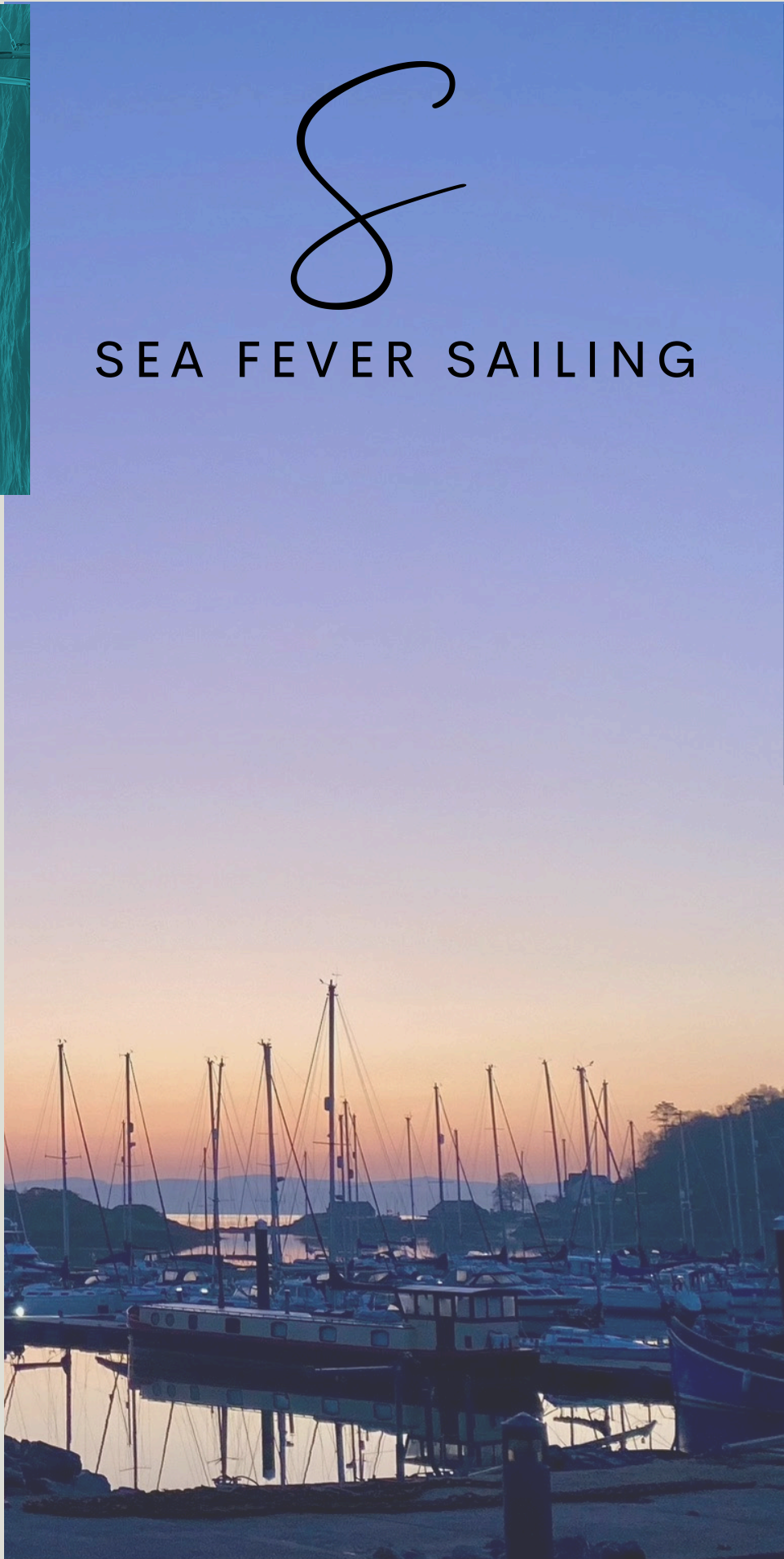

In 1986 Dónal moved to Arran and began his sailing (and music!) apprenticeship. Learning to sail with the Junior Sailing Club and Ocean Youth Club, Dónal went on to study Yacht Design in Glasgow. In 1990, he started skippering small yachts in the Clyde and Northern Ireland.

A Yachtmaster at 24 and Instructor at 25, Dónal worked at the Scottish National Watersports Centre, Cumbrae from 1997-2003 where he cut his teeth with many of the best sailors in the country.

Following a career break, Dónal returned to the sailing world in 2019 and in 2023 he moved to Dunoon and came back to commercial sailing full-time, freelancing for several of the Scottish charter and motor cruising companies. In 2024 he revalidated his RYA Yachtmaster Instructor's certificate and went back to running the full range of RYA courses for sailing schools based in Largs Yacht Haven.

Dónal has been working on Sea Fever Sailing for a few years and feels it's time to bring it to market.



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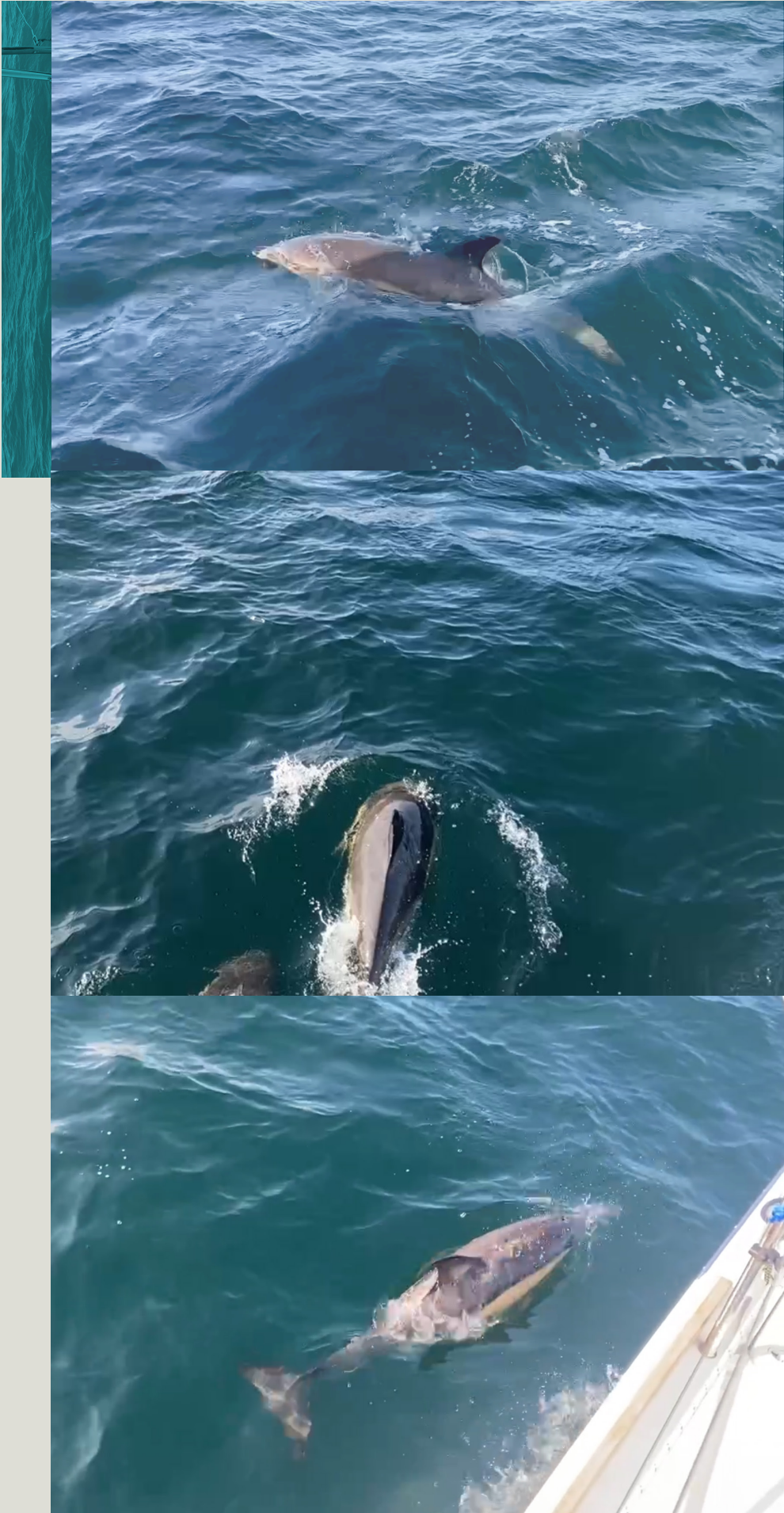
Clyde Islands Holiday Cruises Wildlife

Reservations are confirmed when the completed booking form and a non-refundable deposit of 30% of the total fee has been received.

Provisional bookings by phone or email will be held for a period of 48 hours pending receipt of the completed booking form and deposit. Upon receipt of your deposit we shall send you a confirmation invoice for the balance and advise you of the date of payment of the same. This date is 8 weeks before the start of the cruise.

Every person making a booking on behalf of a passenger or group of passengers warrants and confirms that he/she has the authority of that passenger and that each such passenger/group agrees to be bound by these Terms and Conditions.

Payment will be accepted by BACS.

Clyde Islands Holiday Cruises Cancellations

Cancellations: must be notified to us in writing by the person who made the booking. If you cancel your holiday: More than 56 days prior to the start of your holiday/cruise, you will only be charged your deposit.

Between 56 and 30 days, you will be charged 50% of the holiday/cruise cost.

Between 30 and 14 days, you will be charged 75% of the holiday/cruise cost.

Note: If less than 14 days before the start of your holiday/cruise or on or after the commencement of the cruise, you must pay the full holiday/cruise cost.

Note: We appreciate that wholly unforeseen events may result in cancellation. In view of the above and for your peace of mind we therefore strongly advise you to take out appropriate comprehensive Accident and Cancellation Insurance at the time of your booking. Amendments/Cancellation Administration Fee – Sea Fever Sailing reserves the right to charge an administration fee of £30 in respect of any changes made to a booking after receipt of the 30% deposit.
